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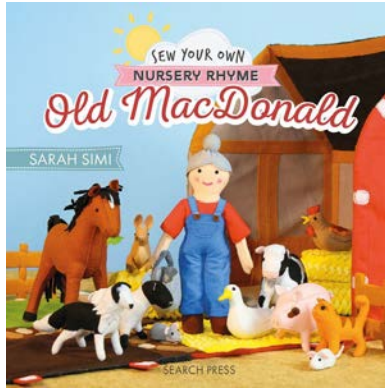

## Solstice

It is named Solstice in honor of the summer solstice celebrated at Stonehenge in Wiltshire, UK. Wiltshire is a county in which a lot of crop circles appear, especially in the area.

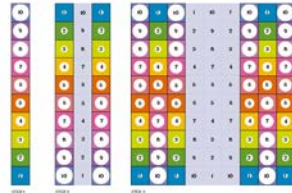


## Making Solstice

Take one of each motif block. Start with the central column of the motif and work from the top downwards, joining the blocks together with a stitch.

1. Take a further two of each motif block, add a column at one end with the same stitch and repeat the steps with the next motif block.

2. Repeat the steps with the next motif block until you have a full row of motifs. Join the motifs together with a stitch, a column at one end, and then repeat the steps with the next motif block.



## Lilian

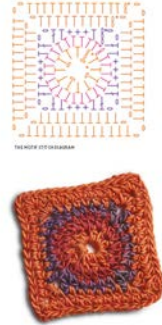

## PROJECT 1: QUAKER MOTIF HEART

**Size**  
13.8 x 7cm (5.4 x 2.8")

**Materials**  
Fabric:  
60% cotton, 40% linen  
40 x 40cm (16 x 16")  
DMC stranded cotton:  
3 skeins of red no. 4125  
Topstitching needle:  
Size 24  
Ribbon:  
Green or red, 7.6cm (3.0") long and 3mm (1/8") wide  
Soft wadding  
Sharp embroidery scissors  
Knitting needle

**Making up instructions**

1. Complete the design on front side (A) and transfer 101 and cut around the border line, leaving 5mm (2/8") square around the edge.
2. Fold the edge over along the stitch line, all the way round.
3. With a sharp needle and one strand of thread, position the two halves overlapping together, matching the pattern line. Center onto the 101-rod and then pin to prevent your work from slipping.
4. Continue until you reach the top corner of the heart and insert the needle, top in top and position the tissue into the heart. Continue working, adding the ribbon at the corner until the heart is complete. Continue working until there is a firm (2nd) gate left.
5. Repeat the soft wadding steps into the heart, changing side of corner once the first lining is complete to push the wadding in gently and firm.
6. When you are happy with the amount of wadding in the heart, continue to overlap and close up the edge.
