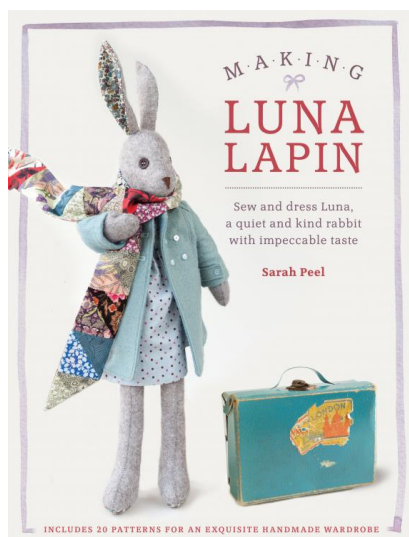

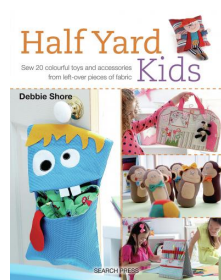

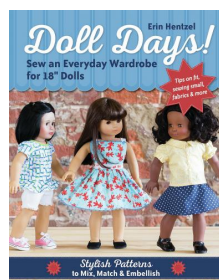
About The Author

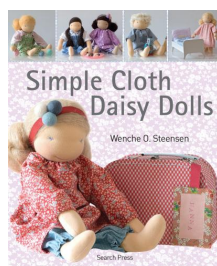
