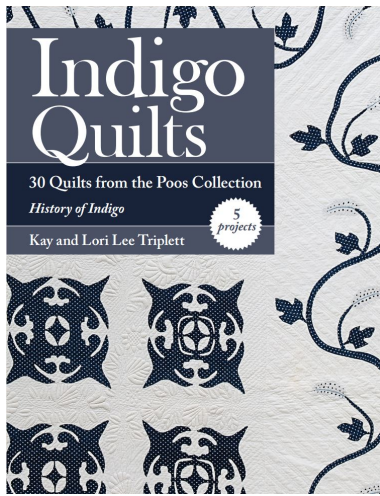

Lori Lee Triplett and her sister, Kay Triplett, received the Lucy Hilty Research Grant and the Meredith Scholar Award for their research work on indigo.

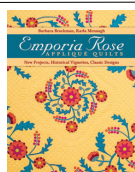
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
