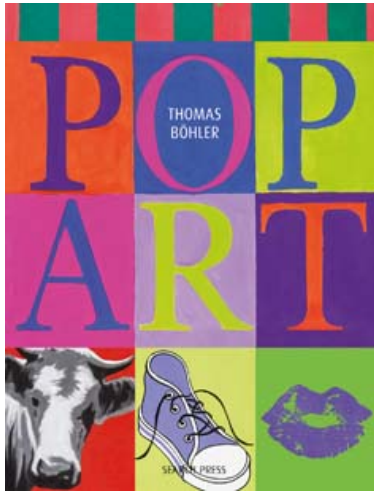

More than just a decorative hobby, this book will inspire you to create your own unique works of pop art.

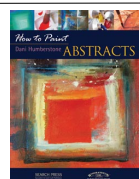
