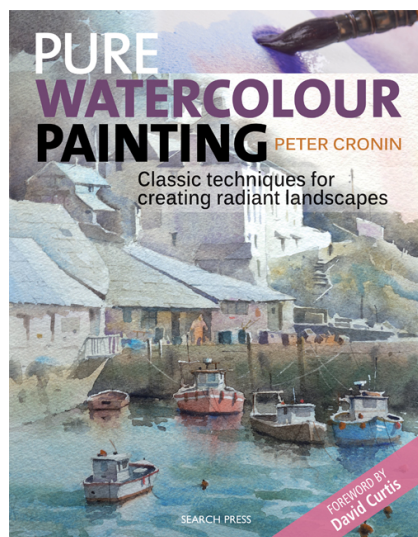

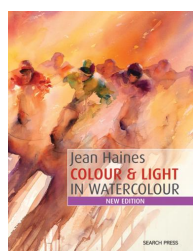

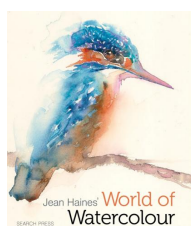
### About The Author
