Only a few basic crochet stitches are needed, and these delightful dolls are perfect for using up scraps of yarn from your stash.

She learned dressmaking and Waldorf doll making, and has been designing and creating dolls and toys ever since. 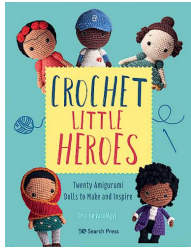

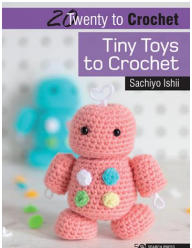

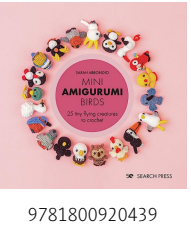
