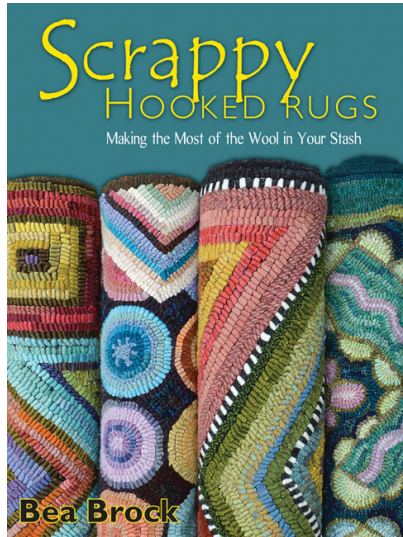

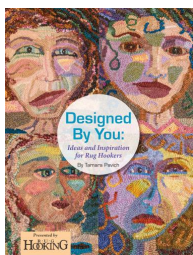

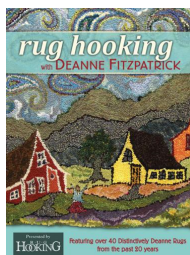
About The Author
