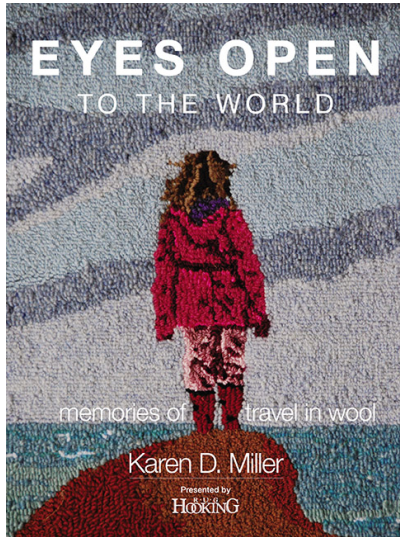


# Eyes Open To The World
